 d. abt. 1758  
 High Sheriff of Pembrokeshire, 1724.  
 Principal landowner in the parish of Cosheston,  
 Pembrokes.  
 Marriage (1742) to Lettice Hawker  
 Lettice d. 1760 aged 41

Nicholas Roch  
 (1744-1817)  
 m. 1765 to Elizabeth  
 Phelps  
 Nicholas d. 1817,  
 buried Cosheston,  
 Pembrokes.  
 Elizabeth d. 1787  
 aged 52 years.

Mark Roch b. abt. 1748, Paskeston,  
 Cosheston, Pembrokes. d. 1/8/1818.  
 m. Margaret Thomas (d.1819)  
 28 Feb. 1795, St. Peter,  
 Carmarthen.  
 M.R. was Mayor of Carmarthen in  
 1812.  
 He was a landowner, died 1 August,  
 1818, and left part of this estate to  
 brother George Roch.

George Roch (1751-1825)  
 m. Ann Bright (1754-1820) 6th  
 November, 1777, Church of St. Michael,  
 The Archangel, Bristol.  
 George is marked on the baptism  
 records of his sons as "leather  
 dresser".  
 Properties owned in Portland St,  
 and Houlton St, Bristol.  
 d. 22/11/1825, buried Bristol.
